### **TOURNAMENT DETAILS**

This is not a knockout tournament.

All competitors play in every round. Swiss pairings will be used.

Chess clocks will be used but help will be given to those who are not used to them. Each player will be allowed 30 minutes per game.

ECF Rapidplay rules will be used.

Results will be posted on the Barnet Junior Chess website and sent for grading.

Parents and friends are welcome to stay, but should note that only stewards and players will be allowed in the playing areas. We do not provide any supervision of children between rounds so you must stay to look after your own children or arrange for another adult to be responsible for your children.
